

António Rendas is currently Rector of the Universidade Nova de Lisboa and was previously Dean of its Faculty of Medical Sciences

After completing his MD and internship in Lisbon he moved to London where he did a PhD in Experimental Pathology in the Cardiothoracic Institute of the University of London. During that period he was a Research Fellow and Honorary Registrar at the Brompton Hospital supported by a grant from the Fundação Calouste Gulbenkian. He then moved to Boston where he was Research Associate in Pathology at the Harvard Medical School and at the Children's Hospital Medical Center. He returned to Portugal where he became Full Professor of Pathophysiology keeping his main field of research in respiratory diseases but with a strong interest in medical education.

He was co-opted to the AMSE Executive Committee in 2006 and elected as a full member in 2007.
