

Professor Colette Creusy, PhD, MD, is head of the department of pathology of the hospitals of the Catholic University of Lille. She has long experience in international activities (including Tempus, Leonardo, and Socrates projects). She was vice-dean for international affairs at the "Faculté Libre de Médecine" (Lille Catholic University) which has 42 Erasmus-Socrates partners. Professor Creusy has been an ICP-Socrates Coordinator, and from the beginning was a member of the Taskforce of MEDNET I and II (Medical Education thematic networks). She has participated as coordinator or partner since 1991 in about 25 European projects. Recently (2007), she was in the pilot team of an INTERREG Health Project (Catholic University and University of Greenwich), and she participated in the activities of the Tuning group of MEDINE (Thematic Network in Medical Education in Europe), coordinated by the University of Bristol. She contributed actively to the European projects EPOWEB (post-graduate on the web), and DEBOMED (implementation of Bologna process into medical education) coordinated by the European Medical Association (EMA). She is in the scientific experts committee of EPODE (Ensemble prévenons l'obésité des enfants: [WWW.epode.fr](http://WWW.epode.fr)), a European Network in the sphere of activity of DG SANCO, coordinated by the Agence Proteines, Paris. She is a partner in a Master's Degree programme in research methodology for Life Sciences (Erasmus). She is the leader of the work package "tuning" in EUROBIOTECH, a thematic network in biotechnology coordinated by the University of Perugia (Italy). She is the leader of the task force "curriculum survey and competences" in EUROPET a Thematic Network in paediatrics. She is a member of ECTS-MA (ECTS Medical Association) and on the board of the EMA.

Formerly an elected member of the AMSE Executive Committee, Professor Creusy was co-opted to the committee in 2007.
