

Professor Ilkka Välimäki was dean of the medical school of the University of Turku, Finland, from 1998 to 2001. His professional background is in paediatrics, becoming Professor of Paediatrics in 1974. A major interest in recent years has been the understanding and development of management skills relevant to the leadership of medical schools. In 2005 he initiated the AMSE programme of workshops to promote the development of education and knowledge on how to manage a medical school. This programme has continued at successive AMSE annual conferences, covering topics such as interactions with the health care system, performance management, performance indicators, mentoring and the like.

He was elected to the AMSE Executive Committee in 2004, and before that was an auditor of AMSE.
