

Jussi Mertsola has worked as a Professor of Paediatrics at the Turku University Hospital, Finland, since 2001. He specialized in Paediatrics 1987 in Turku. After that he did research in The University of Texas Medical Center at Dallas Southwestern Medical School in 1988-1990 and was specialized in Paediatric Infectious Diseases in 1993. He was the chairman of the National Advisory Committee for Vaccination in Finland 2002-9.
