

Maria Rosa Fenoll Brunet is full professor at the University Rovira i Virgili School of Medicine at Reus (Spain). A histologist by academic profession, she studied at Barcelona University where she achieved a Ph D extraordinary grade. She mainly published and taught on neuroscience. She has extensive knowledge about European medical education and some expertise on quality assurance, and has participated in projects for ENQA Quality Agencies in Spain, and for the definition and assessment of the professional competences in medical education in Catalonia (2003-2009).

She has held academic management positions, such as vice dean for international relations, for curricula and registrar at the Rovira i Virgili Medical School from 1995 to 2007. She built up the international relations of this centre and coordinated the Socrates-Erasmus program for Medicine, Physiotherapy and Nutrition

She was member of the team - ECTS Inner Circle of ECTS Medicine group - Executive Board - that designed the EU thematic network in Medical Education MEDINE. Later, representing AMSE, she formed part of the Executive Board of MEDINE and co-chaired the Quality Assurance task force that published the "European Specifications of the WFME Global Standards in Quality improvement of Medical Education".

She was an auditor of AMSE from 2001 to 2003 and elected as a member of the Executive Committee in 2006.
